The International Conference on Research for Development (ICRD) 2017 will focus on research for sustainable development, in particular on improving our understanding of how evidence can support policies for transformation in countries of Africa, Asia, and Latin America. The ICRD series was originally launched in 2004 by the National Centre of Competence in Research (NCCR) North-South and builds on the achievements of these earlier conferences and on the r4d programme – a unique partnership to tackle global challenges. We expect about 300 researchers, policymakers, and societal partners. They will provide sound and timely knowledge from their fields of expertise, and engage in discussing synergies and trade-offs with other SDGs linked to their topics.

Therefore, we are looking for 20 student assistants working at and supporting the conference:
